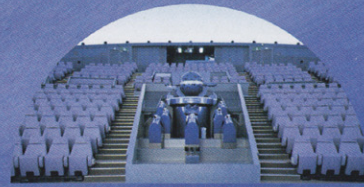


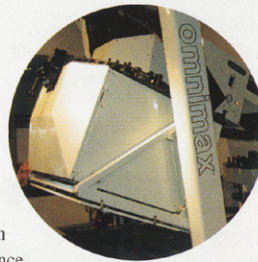
# Planetarium & Omnimax Movie

The Science Museum is proud to integrate planetarium and Omnimax movie system in the very large dome with a diameter of 26.5 m.



## Planetarium Hall Omnimax

With a very large domed screen of the Planetarium Hall, and a 20-degree seating platform, the OMNIMAX launches viewers in the midst of a cinematic experience unlike any other theaters around. The OMNIMAX system uses the largest film frame in the motion picture industry: six times the size of conventional 35mm movie film. The large image surrounds the audience, covering most of the viewers' peripheral vision, producing a sensation much closer to real-life than going to a typical movie theater.



Purchase your tickets on B1F and proceed to the exhibition hall by taking the glass elevator to the 4F level.

Admission for the exhibition hall is free for children.

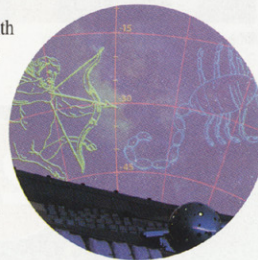

## PLANETARIUM

The planetarium is a huge domed theater where, with the help of a large Konica-Minolta Infinium-L Osaka projector and the Virtuarium II projector of Goto Optical MFG., you are realistically transported to times and places far beyond the realms of everyday experience. Shows are presented four times each day, and the topic changes every three months. Planetarium shows consist of live talks presented by astronomers and multimedia sky shows.

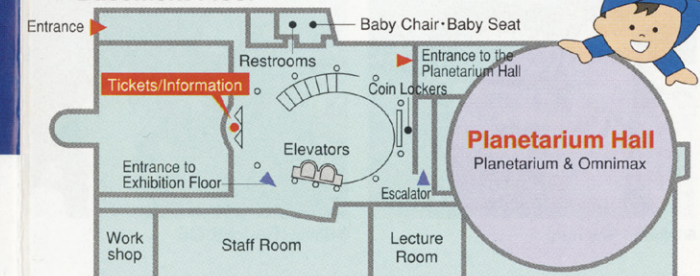
